Agreement of Academic Collaboration

between

In the spirit of promoting international education opportunities European University and Egitisim Business School agree on the following:

- I. To recognize each others' courses, certificates and degrees;
- II. To exchange their experience in the fields of teaching and research in business studies;
- III. To establish and promote new educational endeavors between the institutions;
- IV. To develop annual programs which will comprise, but are not limited to:
 1. Bachelor's, Master's and Doctorate programs
 2. Faculty exchange
 3. Student exchange
 4. Delivery of classes, seminars, forums, summer courses, etc., in which professors and students from both institutions participate.
- V. To treat each other's students as their own.

The present contract can be modified or amended with the agreement of both parties if at least one of them requests it. The modifications and amendments will come into force on the date both institutions sign them.

This agreement shall continue for an indefinite period, but may be terminated by either Egitisim Business School or European University by official, written notification duly signed by the presiding officer of the notifying party. This notice of termination must be received by the other party no later than the end of September of the previous year in which the termination is to become effective.

All controversies that arise in regard to the interpretation and execution of the present agreement will be settled between the two parties in accordance with the laws of Switzerland and Turkey.

Both parties agree on the terms and conditions by signing hereunder.
